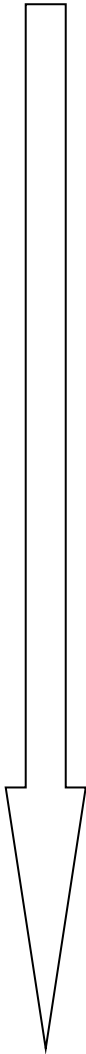
- Mix/match, key words, meanings; examples, Prejudice/Discrimination, Crime/Punishment.
