Suggested revision tools/strategies:

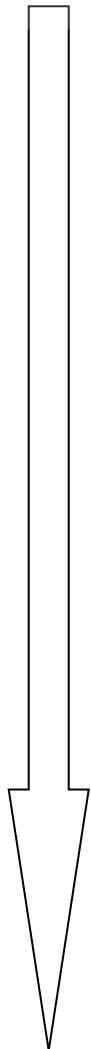
- Mix/match, key words, meanings, examples, Prejudice/Discrimination.
