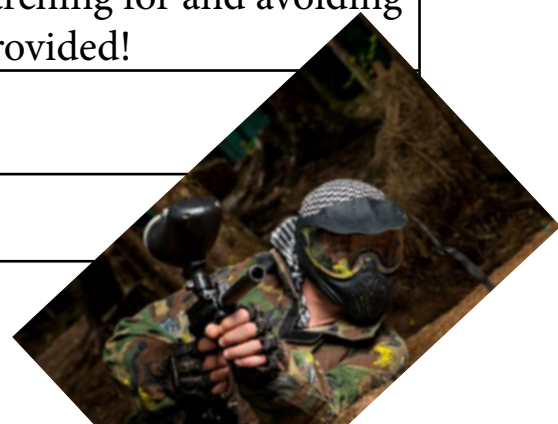


Activity No. 3

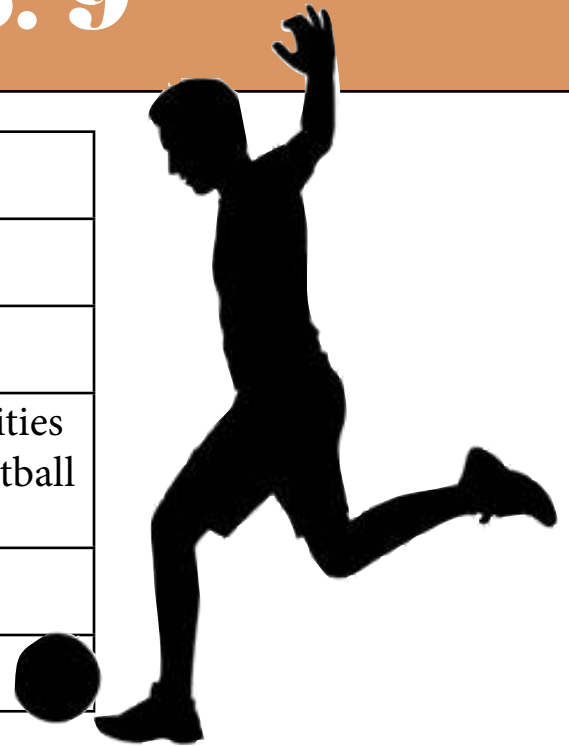
TIK TOK Transformation- Make over fun!

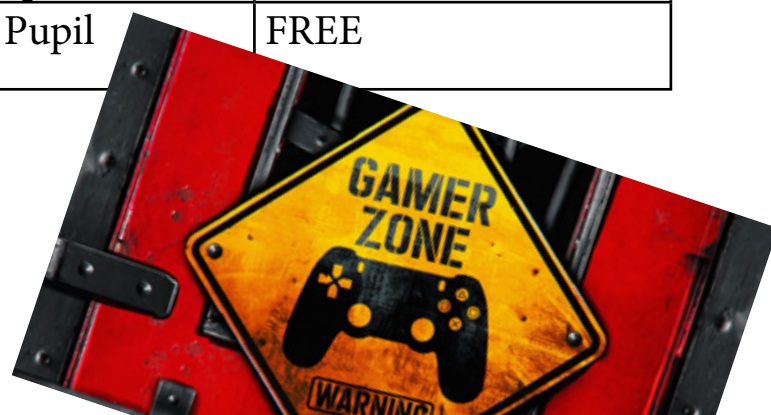

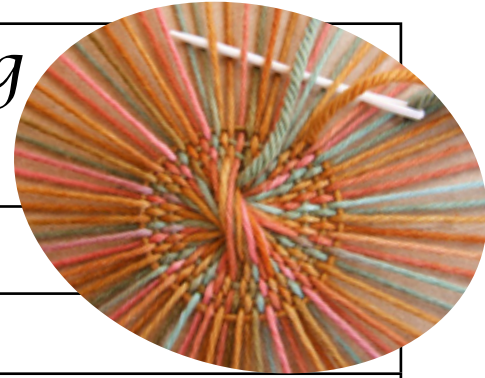
